You do not need to have come to the first class to come to this one. Bibles will be available. Or bring your own.

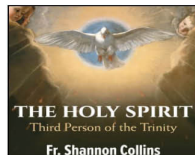

St Catherine Of Siena Parish is seeking a Part-Time Maintenance Technician.

The primary purpose of the **Maintenance Technician** is to maintain and repair physical structures of buildings and grounds, including the parish preschool, by performing a variety of maintenance duties and to ensure a safe and secure environment for all staff, students, and visitors.

Job Duties:

- Perform monthly and weekly building walk-through inspections as required by the Parish's insurance company.
- Maintain and perform minor repairs to building's plumbing, HVAC, and electric including replacing defective parts.
- Assists with repairs to buildings; general carpentry and makes necessary repairs; repairs or replaces building brick, stone, and/or concrete, as directed.
- General grounds maintenance, parking lot and sidewalk repairs, leaf and snow removal, water flowers in landscaping.
- Perform daily set-up for preschool – disinfect doorknobs, water fountains, empty classroom trashcans and set up playground; assemble new playground and classroom equipment.
- Assist with seasonal decorating; use ladder to hang and remove decorations in Church and Preschool.
- Set up and break down for Parish Hall for events – arrange tables, chairs, and equipment as directed.
- Carry boxes and deliveries to the various buildings on the property.

Requirements:

- High school diploma, or equivalent required; certificate from college or technical school in maintenance related field preferred.
- At least 2 years of maintenance experience required; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Specialties in plumbing or carpentry preferred.
- Valid driver's license with a minimum of 3 years driving experience, a good driving record and driving approval from the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.
